Ask her to tell you about her experience over the last 6 months working the UTMB units medical staff trying to get a "Heat Score" so that she can remain in a "Cool Bed" and not be placed in a single cell "Restrictive Housing". When she has severe asthma attacks, she cannot call for help and must rely upon inmates around her to notify the Correction Officers that she is having a medical emergency. This is an extremely serious safety issue.
